Raja Ampat has the highest known concentration and diversity of marine life on earth, with 80% of all the world's coral species, more than 1300 species of fish, 6 of the 7 marine turtle species and 27 of marine mammal. Submerge yourself in the worlds most biodiverse marine ecosystem.

Non-diving activities

With natural beauty all around, relax and unwind on the beach, sun beds, or relax areas. Snorkel our stunning house reef. Take a Kayak and explore the untouched secluded beaches and winding waterways studded with mangroves and dense jungle all a short distance away.

Our Papuan-Style cottages, built by craftsman from the neighboring villages, using local, sustainably sourced materials, are arranged to cause the least disturbance to natural flora and fauna.

With three different types of rooms to choose from, we are sure to have something to suit your budget.

Deluxe cottages: Spacious huts located in the front middle of the beach, with large balconies to relax on, sunbeds on the beach a private pergola and hammocks in the shade. Each hut has its own large en-suite bathroom with a hot and cold water shower.

Superior cottages: Independent cottages located at the far end of the property, each as a large balcony with a hammock, bean bag and private pergola. With an en-suite bathroom with shower.
