



WHAT TO BRING

- ✦ *Swimwear, as most of the time you'll be in the water.*
- ✦ *Hat and sunglasses to protect yourself from the equatorial sun.*
- ✦ *Sturdy walking shoes/sandals if you plan a visit to the birds of paradise.*
- ✦ *Camera, binoculars and a head torch.*
- ✦ *Your preferred toiletries, sunscreen, insect repellent & medications. Do make sure to check that the ingredients used in these products are not harmful to you or to the environment. We recommend OFFICINEA's Clean Beauty App that will help you to check if the products you use are harmless.*
- ✦ *Dive certification card and proof of diving insurance.*
- ✦ *Local data plan: internet signal is very limited on the island. If you need to stay connected purchase a local data plan or let us know and we'll make the necessary arrangements for you.*
- ✦ *We work closely with the neighbourhood villages Yenbeser and Friwen where the living conditions are very basic. If you would like to contribute anything to improve villager's life, feel free to bring books, clothes, educational games, etc.*

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- ✦ *Bath and beach towels: we provide them at the resort.*
- ✦ *Personal care products and cosmetics harmful for humans and the environment. Please make sure you bring one environmental friendly sunblock that does not contain oxybenzone. It can cause the death of animal plankton, coral polyps, fish, shellfish, insects, and in large amounts, can decimate an entire ecosystem.*
- ✦ *Plastic water bottles: we provide drinking water in the cottages, in the dining area and on the boats.*
- ✦ *Plastic: Indonesian waste management systems are poor, therefore we ask all guests to minimise the amount of plastic they use while travelling to Raja Ampat. We kindly ask all our guests to take back the plastic they bring, if any.*
- ✦ *Non-rechargeable batteries: there is no efficient system to recycle them in Raja Ampat.*
- ✦ *Dive gloves: we kindly ask you to leave your gloves at home. We do apply a no-glove policy, as part of our reef protection program.*
- ✦ *Spearfishing equipment.*
- ✦ *Fish ID books: we have plenty here.*
- ✦ *A preventive malaria medicine that may impact your ability to dive safely. Please discuss alternatives with your doctor before you travel.*
